Pool Monitors Needed!

The pool is our largest amenity and one of our biggest assets as a community. Having the pool maintenance company come daily is cost-prohibitive, therefore, the HOA has contracted with a pool maintenance company to clean and service the pool twice a week and clean the restrooms once a week. Therefore, we need volunteers to check the pool on a daily schedule to (i) ensure everything is functioning properly, (ii) ensure the pool is clean and presentable for residents, and (iii) to be alert so that any problems or issues may be caught and corrected in a timely manner.

Just as prior years, we need a team of residents willing to commit to oversee the pool as well as someone to manage the volunteers. Pool monitors will be responsible for checking the facilities once a day to ensure the pool facilities are in proper condition and to unlock/lock the bathrooms in the mornings and evenings (at this time, the restrooms will be closed until volunteers and someone to manage the volunteers is found) Residents will sign-up for one-week intervals and receive a training session from the pool committee. Residents may choose the weeks they will serve so as not to conflict with vacations or family plans. Hopefully, we will have enough volunteers so each volunteer will only have to serve one week and to allow the restrooms to remain open for the entirety of pool season! If you enjoy the pool, please consider offering some of your time to help keep the pool facilities presentable and functioning properly and to help with keeping HOA costs down.
